Enrollment

- Registration is limited and is on a first-come, first-served basis
- Pre-registration is required for all camps
- Registration is held on a weekly basis

Immunization Records

A copy of your child's immunization records must be submitted a minimum of 10 days prior to the camp start date. This is **MANDATORY** and no child will be allowed to participate without submitting these.

Deposit Policy

Registration requires a minimum non-refundable deposit of \$25 per camp to hold your child's spot. The deposit is applied to the balance. Payment in full is due a minimum of 10 days prior to the camp start date or your child will be removed from the roster.

Refund Policy

If your child is unable to attend a camp in which he/she is enrolled, you may request a refund for any amount paid over and above the non-refundable deposit. You must make your request in writing to Workforce Development and Community Education, Summer Camps, via U.S. mail, or by email. The request must be received by the close of business 10 days prior to the Monday that your child is scheduled to begin camp. Please note that refunds for payments made by check may take six to eight weeks to process.

Transfer Policy

If your child is unable to attend a camp in which he/she is enrolled, you may request a transfer of the amount paid for that camp to another camp week that your child is not previously enrolled in, within the same camp season. You may not combine deposits to pay a balance for another camp week in which your child is previously enrolled. You must make your request in writing to Workforce Development and Community Education, Summer Camps, via U.S. mail, or email. The request for the transfer of a deposit must be received by the close of business 10 days prior to the Monday of the camp week that your child was scheduled to attend.

Sign in/Sign Out

All parents/guardians **MUST** sign their child in and out each day. Identification will be checked until the staff knows you. If someone is not listed on your child's registration form as an authorized pick-up person, we will **NOT** release your child. Only individuals 18 years and older may sign a child out. Please make sure that anyone authorized to pick up your child arrives with a photo ID!

Late Fee/Extended Care

Any camper not registered for extended care, arriving prior to 8:45 a.m. and/or not picked up by Noon, for AM camps, or 4 p.m., for PM camps, will be assigned to our extended care program. Extended care tuition of \$39/child will be due at the time of drop off and/or pick-up.

Lunch

If your child is attending a full-day camp or has selected two half-day camps, they may bring a brown bag lunch. No refrigeration is available. Water is available, but please bring a refillable bottle.

Clothing

Students should dress appropriately for the class that they will attend. Class descriptions will provide the necessary requirements. Temperatures fluctuate in some of our classrooms, so please remember to bring a sweater or sweatshirt.

Electronic Devices

Campers should **NOT** bring electronic devices. Delaware Tech will not be responsible for any lost, broken or stolen property. Please do not bring a cell phone.

Sunscreen

Campers will be participating in many outdoor activities. To be prepared for the sun, apply sunscreen every morning before coming to camp. Campers may also bring more sunscreen with them to camp.

Emergency Procedures

Upon registration, all campers will be changed to be enrolled in our Summer Camps Alert System. More information will be emailed to parents/guardians.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

Medical Procedures

Each camper is required to have personal medical coverage and accident insurance. Delaware Tech does not provide this coverage. Parents will be informed immediately in the event of an emergency. The parents will be responsible for picking up the camper and determining if further medical attention is necessary. In case of an emergency requiring immediate medical attention, camp staff is required to: make the child comfortable, call for an ambulance, and notify the parent and camp manager who will accompany the child to the hospital.

Problem Management Procedures

Discipline problems will be addressed in the following manner: Behavioral problems will be handled by the camp manager. If the problem persists, the parent will be notified. If the problem continues to persist, the camper will be dismissed from camp and will not be permitted to return. Refunds will not be granted if campers are dismissed from camp. Automatic dismissal from camp may occur at the camp manager's discretion.

Financial Assistance

Delaware Technical Community College offers financial assistance to support families. The availability of funds varies from year to year and is income-based. Only completed applications with required documents will be considered.

- Approved applicants will be required to make a \$25 non-refundable deposit per camper

- Financial assistance is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
- There is a maximum of \$400 per child for the 2024 camp season.
- Deadline for submission of all the required documentation is June 7, 2024 for summer camps.
- You are encouraged to submit all forms as early as possible.
- Financial assistance is awarded by June 21, 2024.

- I understand that Delaware Technical Community College will not assume responsibility for accidents and/or medical or dental expenses received as a result of participation in the camp/s.
- I give permission to Delaware Technical Community College to dispense the medication(s) listed on the Medication Administration Form, if any, to my child according to the information provided above. In the event that the emergency contacts cannot be reached, I hereby grant Delaware Technical Community College permission to give whatever immediate treatment is necessary and/or take my child to the nearest Hospital Emergency Room. - Deposits: Any required deposit of your camp payment is considered a deposit to hold your child's camp seat. All deposits are non-refundable.
- Refund: If your child is unable to attend a camp in which he/she is enrolled, you may request a refund for any amount paid over and above the non-refundable deposit. You must make your request in writing to Workforce Development and Community Education, Kids on Campus via U.S. mail, or email at the address located at the bottom of the first (1) registration page. The request must be received by the close of business 10 days prior to the Monday that your child is scheduled to begin camp. Please note that refunds for payments made by check may take six to eight weeks to process.
- Transfer Policy: If your child is unable to attend a camp in which he/she is enrolled, you may request a transfer of the amount paid against that camp to another camp week that your child is not previously enrolled in, within the same camp season. You may not combine deposits to pay a balance for another camp week previously enrolled in. You must make your request in writing to Workforce Development and Community Education, Kids on Campus via U.S. mail, or email at the address located at the bottom of the first (1) registration page. The request for the transfer of a deposit must be received by the close of business 10 days prior to the Monday of the camp week that your child was scheduled to attend.
